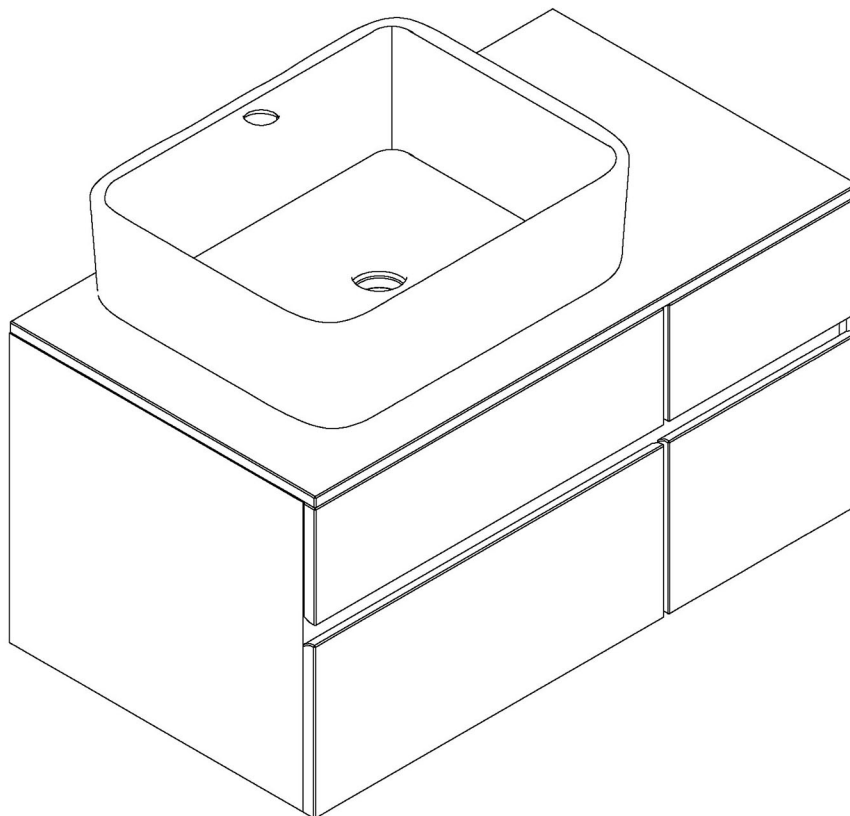

Assembly Instructions

- **When assembling place all parts on a soft, clean, and flat surface such as a carpet to prevent scratches.**
- **During assembly, align all screws with the corresponding pre-drilled holes first and then tighten them one by one.**

Use and Maintenance

- 1.Keep the furniture vacant for half a month before use, and maintain good indoor ventilation to eliminate the residual odor in furniture surface coating.
- 2.Avoid the use of all chemicals, household cleaners and abrasives that may damage finish
- 3.Excessive exposure to sunlight and extreme changes in temperature and moisture can damage wood furniture.
- 4.Avoid placing hot appliances, such as curling irons and hot hair dryers directly on the counter top. Avoid placing extremely heavy items on the countertop.
- 5.Teach children not to play close to the glass sharp angles of furniture avoid accidental physical injury and damage to the furniture.
- 6.Open the doors and drawers of the furniture with appropriate force, and it is strictly forbidden to open and close them violently, which will cause loose connections.
- 7.Screws may become loose during long-term use. If necessary, retighten them to ensure stability and security.

Trouble Shooting

Problem	Cause Analysis	Handling Method
Door opening is not flexible	The furniture is not leveled	Use items to level the furniture
	The door hinges should be adjusted properly.	Adjust door hinges and apply lubricating oil
Inflexible opening of drawer	Overload or deformation	Reduce weight,adjust guide rails, lubricate
Loose component connection	Loose hinges or screws	The poke part should be coated with an appropriate amount of 502 glue,then re-install or tighten the screws.
Minor scratches	friction with hard or sharp objects	Use a brush to apply similar pigment ink along wood grain to the scratches,then wipe off the excess.
Water spots or rings	Caused by minerals left behind when water evaporates	These can be removed by buffing the spots gently with 00 gauge steel wool.
